Creating a Style from Scratch

Use Stable Diffusion to craft a visual style for your comic.

Before You Begin

This tutorial uses the base Stable Diffusion 1.5 checkpoint on Automatic1111. Adaptations may be necessary for different checkpoints or image generators (like Midjourney).

Step 1. Determine Story Needs

Determine the basic feel, colors, and weights you want for your style. This will largely be influenced by the story that you want to tell. The setting and tone guide the visual feel of the story. A tragic story needs appropriate shadows and line weight. A somber feeling creates the visual language that your story lives in. A coming-of-age story will have a lighter color palette and different use of shadows. For this example, we will create a style for a dark sci-fi post-apocalyptic story of redemption.

Step 2. Gather Style References

Research and review artistic * styles, disciplines, and movements. If you are creating a manga story, your style will be much different than if you are creating a gritty wild west American style graphic novel. Explore different styles and elements of style. You may be surprised at how different styles blend to create a unique aesthetic. You can

review styles at this link to get ideas: <https://ckovalev.com/midjourney-ai/styles>

Be aware that there are no wrong styles, only wrong applications of styles for particular projects. Your aesthetic preference is the final determinant of the correct style. We like what we like, right?

*This tutorial uses styles only. No artist names were harmed in the making of this tutorial.

Step 3. Brainstorm Story Locations

Select some interesting locations for your action to take place. Your reader/viewer wants to enter



this world of your imagination. There are no limits. Go wild and be creative. Your list of locations will build into your style and overall story aesthetic.

Step 4. Build Your Prompt

Use the elements of your location and style to build your prompt. Keep in mind the needs of your story. If you are creating a black and white manga, you don't need "full-color concept art matte painting" in your prompt. Generate environments and settings to explore the strengths and weaknesses of your style.



Step 5. Fix What Doesn't Work

The process of discovering the right style for your story will take some time. When you find something worth keeping, save the prompt and explore further. Creativity rewards work. Success is an ongoing process, not a destination.

Crafting the Prompt

This story is going to explore a bounty hunter in a post-apocalyptic society. He was forsaken by society for a crime he did not commit. He wants to return to the city of lights, but right now he lives in the shadows. The bounty hunter is searching for the ones that can clear his name with the law in the violent tribal society that rules this land. This story is influenced by film noir, gritty pulp sci-fi comics, and post-apocalyptic stories like Fallout.

We need strong shadows, muted colors, and messy lines. This isn't going to be a Neo-Tokyo. This is Neo-Sparta. It needs to feel gritty. As a hint for the prompt, "watercolor paper" adds texture to the rendered image.

Styles

Some styles that could work to explore the story of a man who doesn't belong are: deconstructivism, concept art, futurism, panfuturism, and post-impressionism.



The world he lives in isn't his reality. These styles will help to create a visual world that appears different from the one we know. This aesthetic can help to explore the deconstruction of the man's reality and his journey toward redemption.

Locations

Some visually interesting locations that could factor into the story are: an amusement park, shopping mall, power station, waste water processing plant, rooftop garden, traveling circus, mayor's castle of clouds, and a drive-in movie theater.



Prompt - Attempt #1

Here is what we start with from our research:

stylized graphic novel illustration, environmental concept art matte painting, post-apocalyptic amusement park, style of deconstructivism and panfuturism and post-impressionism, inspired by pulp sci-fi comic art, gritty tribal vibes, detailed, dramatic lighting, chiaroscuro, olive-green and sepia and rust tritone print on watercolor paper

Note that this prompt does not include a negative prompt. In Stable Diffusion, a negative prompt creates a secondary (unseen) visual that tells the generator what the final image should not look like. Some examples of negative prompt terms are: conjoined twins, too many limbs, weird eyes, signature, watermark, low resolution, text, cropped, low quality, jpeg artifacts, username, out of frame, deformed, blurry, out of frame, triptych, diptych, text.



Automatic1111 (and almost every other Stable Diffusion interface) provides a text field for negative prompts on both the txt2img and img2img tabs.

Results

The images here are picked from renders of the prompt we created. This is an interesting start, but it needs something else. Back to the prompt for more work.

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A RETROSPECTIVE LOOK INTO COMIC BOOK ART CREATION USING AI GENERATIVE TOOLS

Throughout history, humans have used tools to create art. Whether it was ancient cave drawings crafted by charcoal, Da Vinci's Mona Lisa, painted in oils, or more recently, Andy Warhol's use of photography in his art. One thing that has remained consistent is the desire for human expression.

In the same essence, Artificial Intelligence (AI) has brought about a revolution in almost every form of art in our lives. Its impact has touched the fields of digital art, music, literature, and more. However, one area that has significantly benefited from AI is the comic book industry. Using AI in this field has revolutionised the traditional methods of making comics, and created a new kind of illustration.

AI art involves the use of algorithms and computer-generated programs to create art with little human intervention. Using prompts and the specific organisation of words, one

can now generate full art pages, panels, and images. In the comic book industry, AI art allows creators to generate art and comic frames with great speed and efficiency. It also allows them to create with a high level of precision, making the entire process more time and cost-effective while focusing on the story and other elements of creation.

It has not been perfected, but with corrective measures and modifications in post-production, generated images will soon be impossible to differentiate from human art.



One of the significant impacts of AI art on traditional comic book artists is that it has removed the monotonous and time-consuming process of hand-rendering each frame of the comic book. AI art creation is like rotoscoping, which involves tracing over live-action footage, frame-by-frame, to create realistic animation. With AI art, all that is required is to feed the program with the required data, and then the program will generate art frames with high precision and accuracy within minutes.

Traditional comic book artists and creators can now focus their energies on the creative aspects rather than spending hours rendering the simplest of objects. They can then modify images using tools such as Photoshop, Procreate, and with other AI tools, such as Dall-e 2's out-painting feature.

With AI art, it only takes a few minutes to produce a complete page of a comic book, whereas the

traditional approach could take days, if not weeks. This means that creators can produce a larger volume of content in a shorter time, which can be a significant factor in the highly competitive comic book industry.

AI art tools are very similar to photography and collage arts, where the artist combines different elements to create something new. The generative aspect of AI art allows artists to explore and create entirely new concepts that may not have been possible using traditional methods. This not only brings a new level of creativity to the comic book industry, but also adds a new dimension to art creation.

Despite these benefits, some in the comic industry view AI art as a threat to traditional artists and creators. There is also the moral and ethical dilemma surrounding how AI tools were trained without the consent of traditional artists.

However, AI generative art involves using algorithms and machine learning to create unique artwork without explicitly reproducing any pre-existing artwork. The technology behind AI art allows for the creation of entirely new and

unique pieces, making it distinct from art theft and plagiarism. Depending on the software you use, and how you modify the art, you can create completely original work by using image-2-image or blend options, which are now found in programs such as Stable Diffusion and Midjourney. These tools allow you to create your own dataset using ethically sourced images.

Ultimately, AI generative art is a new and innovative approach to creating art that does not rely on copying or appropriating existing works. It learns from previous works, no different from a comic book artist or illustrator referencing other art, and it does not copy images directly, unless programmed that way.

It is important to acknowledge that AI art is another tool to create, just like a DJ creating music by sampling and remixing various sounds. It is not a replacement for traditional art forms, but a supplement to it. Traditional artists can still use their skills

and techniques to make unique and engaging comic books.

The future of AI art and comic book creation is changing rapidly. New tools are emerging on a consistent basis, and AI is changing the way we view, think, and, most importantly, the way we communicate through visual mediums and with each other.

There is an uphill struggle for AI art creators, but there is also a light at the end of the tunnel. Like any new form of technology that was criticised before it, there will be a time for healing and adjustment to AI art and comic book making, and I myself can't wait to see what wonders this technology will bring!

FROM THE EDITOR MOAR

Here we are. The first collaborative zine for AI art and storytelling. If you are reading this, you are a part of the beginning. You are not only witnessing history, you are the vanguard (as wAlter fuEgo would say) of a revolution in visual storytelling. Thanks to text-to-image generation, the gates are open, and a flood of creativity is washing in. In art, comics, animation, and more, new creatives are emerging, and they are bringing with them fresh perspectives and fresh ideas.

The first comics published in 2022 came in with an almost surrealist approach. With the limitations of AI art, what we saw then were primarily atmospheric works that relied on prose for the connectivity of the story. I am thinking of works such as *LungFlower* by Brian Martinez. The images created by Brian in collaboration with Midjourney surrounded the reader in an eerie, artistic beauty that later

morphed into a tale of dark horror. The artwork really nailed home the feel of the story, despite the limitations of the technology at the time.

Later, of course, *Zarya of the Dawn* by Kristina Kashtanova would gain traction and take center stage as the world waited to see whether they could copyright an AI comic in the United States—and they did. While much has yet to be determined in terms of AI generated images themselves, comic books can now be copyrighted in the U.S. Which is huge.

I would be remiss if I didn't mention Steve Coulson and his *Bestiary Chronicles*, which blew my mind with their character and style consistency so early in AI art evolution. Steve was and is a trailblazer for the potential of AI comics. As are other creators such as Christopher English, who's upcoming manga, *I Think My King Might Be a Lil' Bitch*, looks hand drawn and amazes me.

New communities are forming thanks to these trailblazers. Not only do we have Facebook groups such as *AI Comic Book Creators* and *ARTOfficial Comics*, but we also have Discord servers like *AI Comic Books* and *Making Modern Comics and Books*, and websites like [Alcomicbooks.com](https://alcomicbooks.com), all dedicated to sharing and teaching how to create visual storytelling with AI tools.

This is just the beginning. At the rate this technology is moving, and with the limitless potential of artificial intelligence, I consider myself lucky to be among all of you at this starting point in AI history.

diffusion is open source, software. Meaning anyone can download it, install it, and use it to instantly deliver results. Companies of all sizes can implement it into their products immediately, as well as use the open source software to develop proprietary solutions of any kind. The limit of the solution is only the imagination and business planning of the company.

We have showcased over 40 books in this issue as a way to present what has been done, and a vision of what's to come. A number of the creators are working creative professionals that are working under pseudonyms, to avoid the blackballing and potential loss of their clients/reputation. It's important to put

a flag in this as it will be a footnote to how this new industry started, and to those that were threatened online and with violence, but let's just leave it at that and move on to the positive.



Text-to-image technology releases the imagination and empowers the storyteller. We hope it brings a new generation of storytellers, new audiences, and new kinds of books.

This premier issue shows almost every first book created with text-to-image, as well as books recently completed. We call the early books "first generation" books, and the current books "second generation."
